'I am to the west of Skull Rock and to the south of the Forest of No Return.

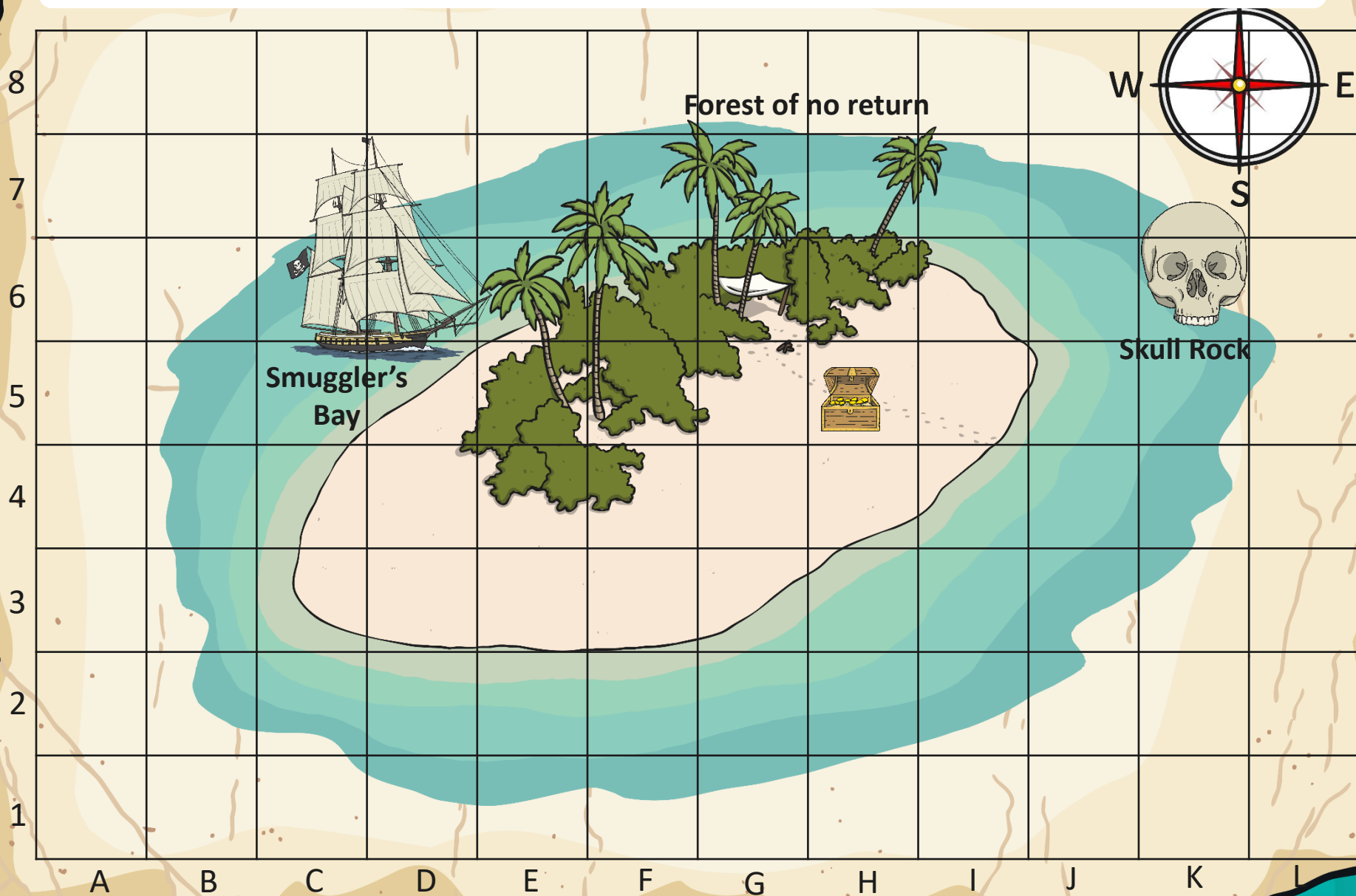


You found the treasure!

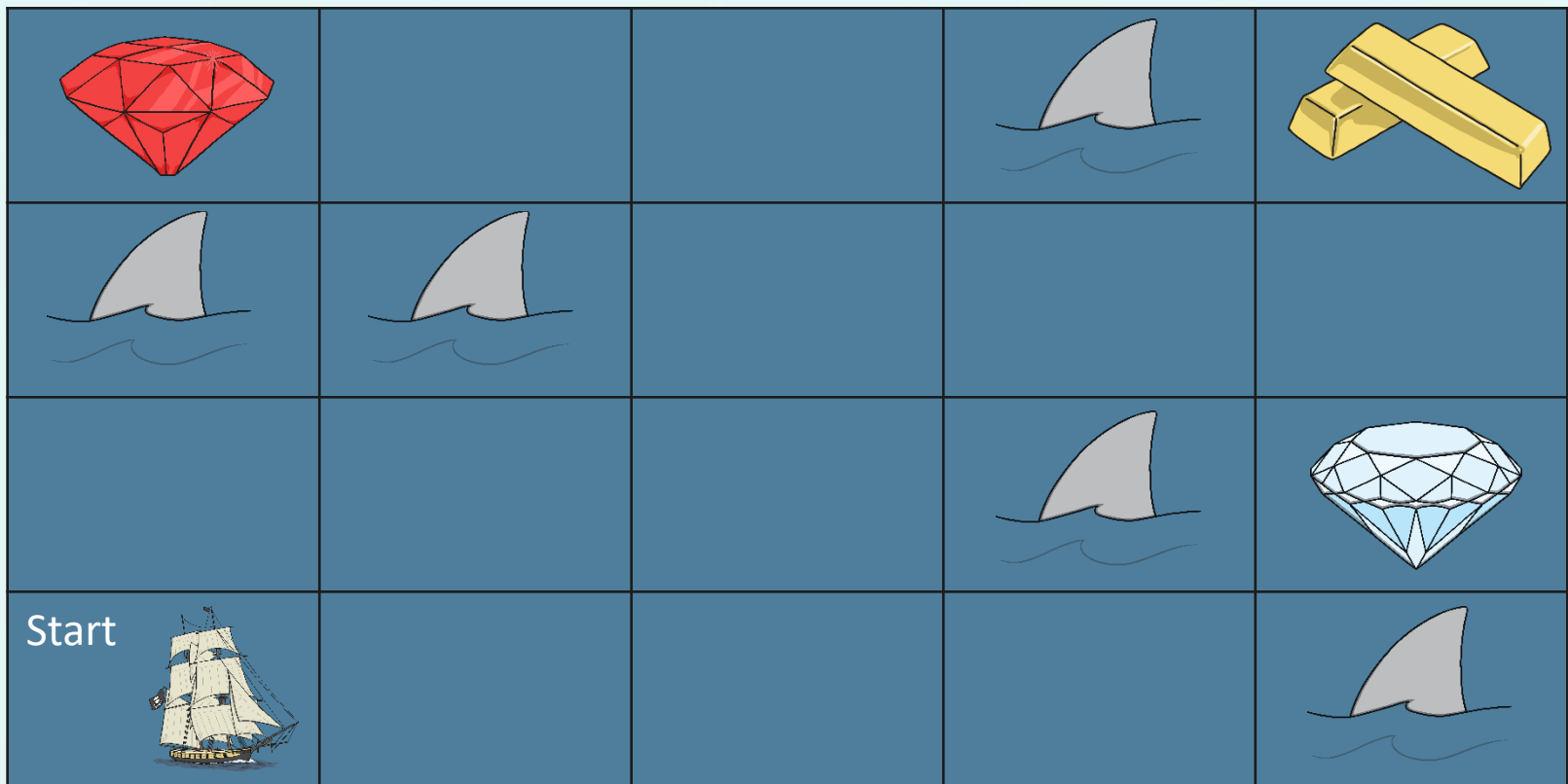
