If you write your report as a letter, you will need to think about how you will present your work. You can still use subheadings to help organise your information within a letter (you have used subheadings in previous non chronological reports).

Once you have designed your trainer, we would like you to think about a radio advert to advertise your trainer.

What will you say to encourage people to buy your trainer?

Will you give your trainers a 'catchy' name?
