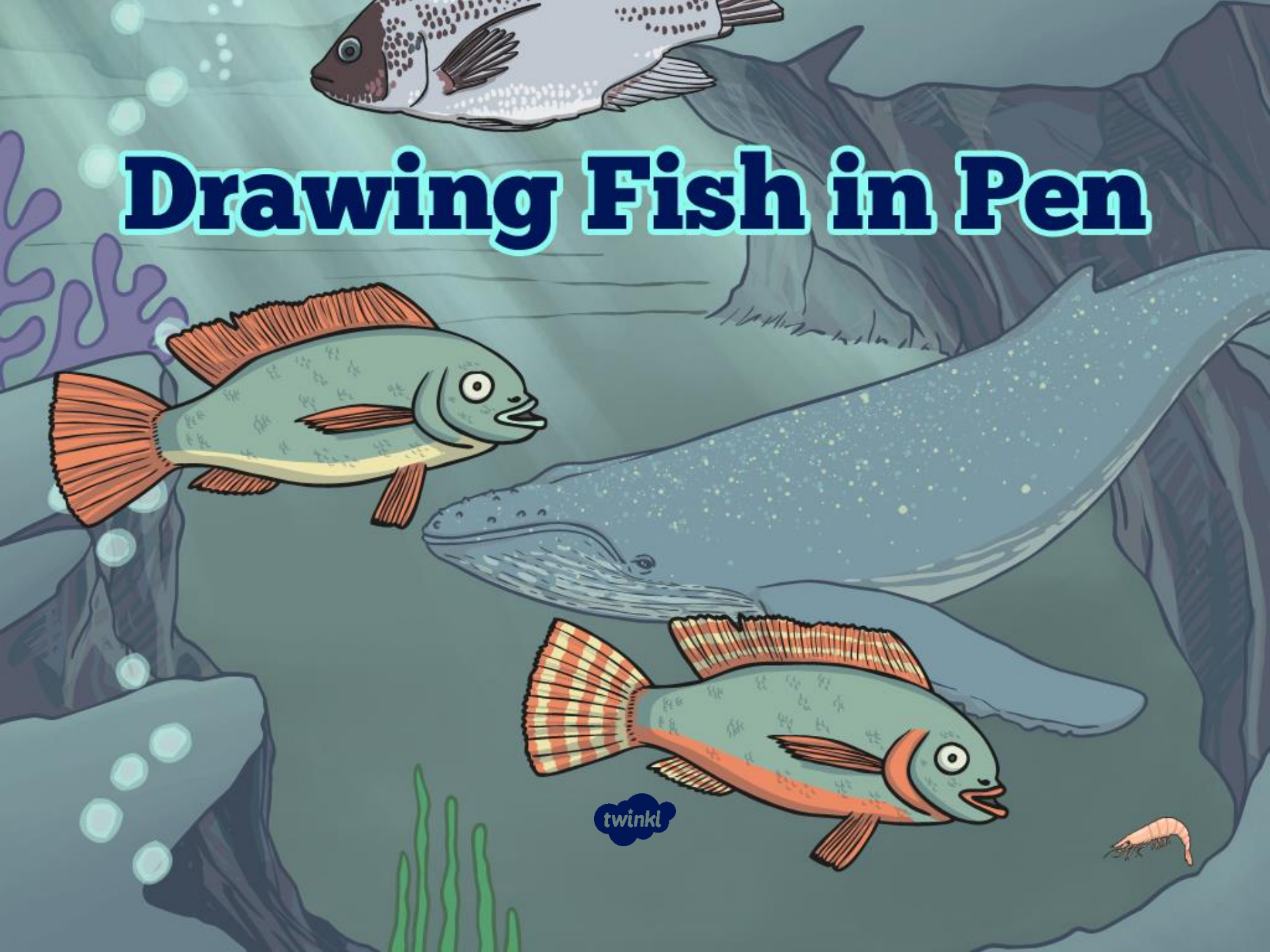

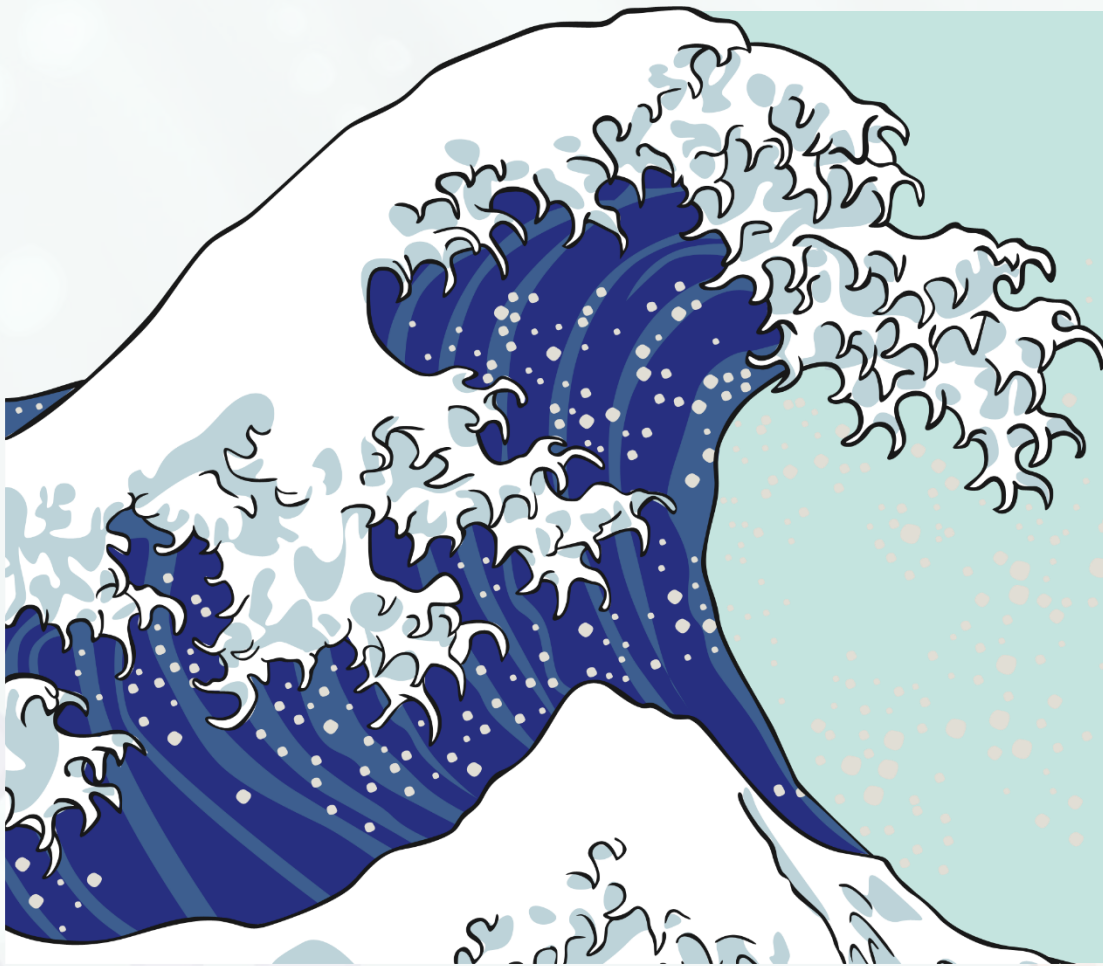

What key details do you notice?


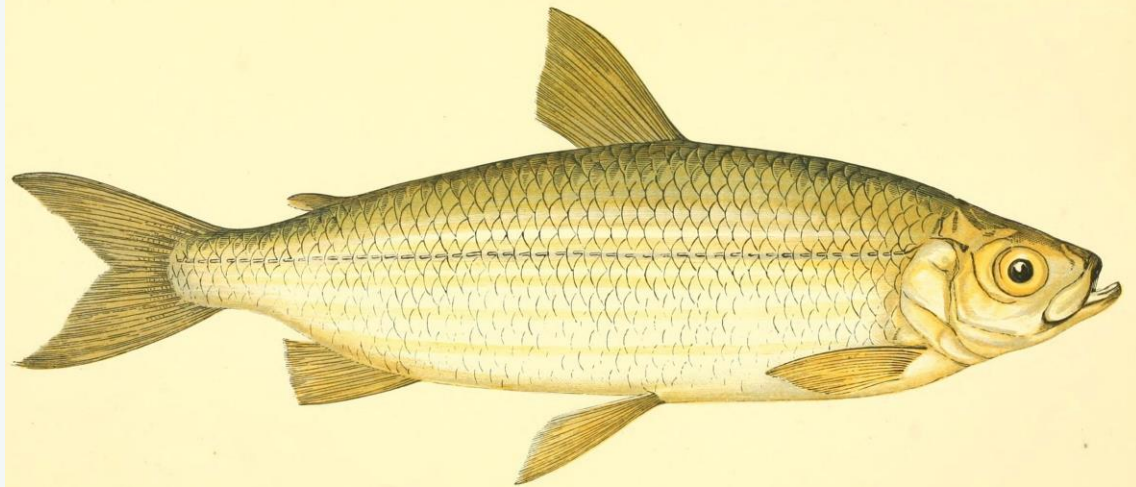

Your Task


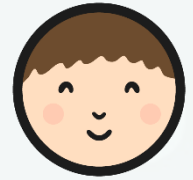
- Use pen or pencil to draw a picture of the fish on the next slide.
