


L.C. Can you identify and locate a range of countries and their capital cities in South America?

• If you were unsure, how could you find out?



- You also need to show the location and name of each capital city for the countries that you label.







- Use the search bar to find 'Brazil' – this should take you to an image of South America.
- Use the zoom out function on the RHS to allow you to see the continent as a whole.




- Take a few
