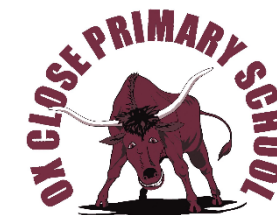

<b>LC</b>	<p>Can you retell the story of the Rainbow Fish?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Introduce the story the Rainbow Fish to the class. What do we think the story is about? Why?</li><li>• Read the story and discuss with the class. Why does the rainbow fish not want to share his scales? What happens when he won't share? Where does he go for help and what happens? What does the rainbow fish do? How does he feel at the end of the story?</li><li>• Show the children some pictures from the story and ask them to sequence them by placing them in order / standing in order with the pictures. Model orally saying a sentence about each picture before writing it down. Check for CL, FS, FS. With y2 children encourage use of adjectives and adverbs.</li></ul> <p>Activity: Retell the story of the Rainbow Fish</p> <p>Differentiation: Sequence pictures and retell verbally. Sequence pictures and write a sentence. With T support, retell story in writing using pics and discussion as prompts</p>	<p>Can you write a description of the Rainbow Fish?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Recap the story of the Rainbow Fish. How does it move?</li><li>• Pick out key words from the story which describe the Rainbow Fish.</li><li>• Model writing a description of the Rainbow Fish.
