Lesson input	Use the Seaside through the ages Powerpoint, looking at slides 2 and 3 to discuss what can be seen in each of the photos of the seaside. Talk about what different sources we can find to get different pieces of information from. Look at the information sheets and read them together, picking out interesting pieces of information.	Recap on the information children made notes on yesterday. Explain that we are going to write a postcard to tell people about a seaside holiday in the past. Model writing a postcard, talking about what information you might include eg: what you wore / took to the beach, how you got there / what you did / what you saw.	Use Slide 1 on Seesaw to look at pictures of the seaside in the past and talk about what has changed and what has stayed the same over time. Encourage use of correct vocabulary to talk about the events. Explain to Y2 children what their activity is today, without modelling – this is being used as an assessment piece.	Recall – learning how to weave our placemats. Q What did we learn? Warp, weft, loom, Q What techniques did we practise? Under over. Use slides to remind chn of examples of textiles art with added decoration. Q Which materials have been used? What effect do they have? Use slides to Introduce the artist Gustav Klimt and share examples of some of his decorated artworks. Children to respond to questions about how and why Klimt decorated his work.	

	<p>Explain that we are going to do an activity over two lessons to tell people about seaside holidays in the past.</p> <p>Model highlighting sections of the text and putting interesting points on to post it notes around pictures of the past.</p>			<p>Explain we are going to add decoration to our placemats. Show available materials and discuss how they could be used.</p>	
Activity	<p>Year 1 Children to label a picture with things specific to seaside holidays in the past eg: donkey rides, pier, bathing machines etc.</p> <p>Year 2 Children to work in small groups to make notes of interesting facts about seaside holidays in the past. These could be done on post it notes and stuck around the photo sheet provided for Y1 children.</p> <p>Extension activities: Make a pier from construction / junk Design a kite Write postcard from the beach in 1900. Research the beach in the past and find an interesting fact. Draw a picture of the beach on the computer.</p>	<p>Year 1 Children to use small world people, animals and wooden blocks to make a seaside scene from the past. Label key features and write captions to explain their display to someone else. Photo evidence.</p> <p>Year 2 Children to write a postcard about a seaside holiday in the past.</p> <p>Extension activities: Make a pier from construction / junk Design a kite Write postcard from the beach in 1900. Research the beach in the past and find an interesting fact. Draw a picture of the beach on the computer.</p>	<p>Year 1 Children to draw a picture of something they may have done or seen at the seaside in the past and write a sentence about it.</p> <p>Year 2 Complete worksheet with timeline and sentences.</p> <p>Extension activities: Make a pier from construction / junk Design a kite Write postcard from the beach in 1900. Research the beach in the past and find an interesting fact. Draw a picture of the beach on the computer.
